Please note:

- You have the option of staying either two nights (Friday & Saturday) or three nights (Friday, Saturday & Sunday.)
- The weekend begins Friday with dinner and ends after lunch on either Sunday (for the two-night package) or Monday (for the three-night package.)
- Two night package includes 2 dinners, 2 breakfasts, 2 nights lodging, tax, gratuities and an activity fee.
- Three night package includes 3 dinners, 3 breakfasts, 3 nights lodging, tax, gratuities an activity fee.
- Food is wholesome and hearty! If you have specific needs, the Pinkham staff will assist you.
- Pinkham charges an additional fee (\$25/night/empty bed) for a 4-person room with only two people. As always, this option depends on availability.
- You will be able to request with whom you want to share a room.

Music Activities:

- Instrumentalists and singers will combine for an informal performance of Haydn's *The Creation* on Saturday night, conducted by Beth Norton.
- Friday evening, singers will rehearse with Ms. Norton, while instrumentalists will gather to play works for chamber orchestra or large mixed ensembles.
- On Saturday afternoon there will be a rehearsal with both instrumentalists and singers.
- Sunday evening Cabaret – open to any and all who wish to perform.
- Other music activities include a chamber music mixer, ad hoc chamber music and informal choral singing.
