

AMC Boston Chapter Trails Committee - Boston Area Trail Project

The Spy Pond trail project for 2019 will continue the work along the south end of the Pond that was started in 2005. The work planned for this year includes brushing out of the walkway and hardened shoreline access paths, brushing in side paths, and clearing any winter blow downs off the path. The Boston Chapter Conservation Committee will also be planting native species to stabilize the shoreline soil and provide wildlife habitat. The Spy Pond Environmental Task Group volunteers will be working on the path focusing on invasive plant removal and trash clean-up.

Trail volunteers can participate for either the morning or afternoon work sessions or stay for the whole day. Bring your lunch and enjoy the view of the pond from the stone bench built by the AMC professional and volunteer trail crews whether participating for half the day or the whole day.

Bring: Tools and safety equipment will be provided. Clothing should be appropriate for the weather. Leather work gloves and boots are recommended for hand and foot protection. We work rain or shine.

Participants should bring their own water/lunch, with snacks being provided by the Vision 2020 Spy Pond Environmental Task Group.
